March 15th Making plans - perhaps bring a picture of your plot as we share plans for the new season. Bring along any spare veg seeds to swap

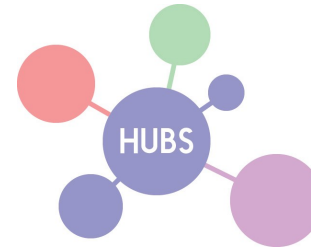
April 12th Flower power - flower seed swap and flower garden planning
