### **A message from Jane Andrews about her skiing...**

"I am one of 16 Special Olympics athletes attending the Great Britain Nationals from 1st—8th February in Switzerland. I will be competing in 3 ski races, Slalom, Giant Slalom and the Super Giant Slalom. This will be my 4<sup>th</sup> GB Nationals competition with the South East Ski Team, my 5<sup>th</sup> in total on snow when you include the World Winter Games, and my 2<sup>nd</sup> competition on snow at Advanced (top level, that you can be at any sport with the Special Olympics).

Please pray for my parents and I as we travel on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> February. We fly to Turin in Italy, then we have a 4 hour coach transfer from Turin to Crans Montana, Switzerland.

I will keep you all posted as to how I get on at this event, the support I've received from you all is greatly appreciated, it means such a lot to me."
