The young man was coming to Jesus, thinking he had to be good and do the right things to earn eternal life, but deep down knowing that wasn't enough. Jesus wasn't disappointed in him, or frustrated that he hadn't realised that he needed more, He just loved him.

Jesus loved him in his imperfection, and yet He wanted to challenge him to draw even closer to Him and to live the life Jesus knew was best for him.

Maybe today you just need to know that Jesus looks at you and loves you, regardless of how you feel or how well you think you are measuring up.

But knowing that Jesus loves you, does He want to challenge you with anything today? Is there something you know you need to do to come closer to God or to live the life He wants you to live? If there is, let Him challenge you through His love.
