Both those things felt like obvious God interventions to me at the time, but it made me wonder how many other things like that happen all the time that I just don't recognise or see, because I'm too busy to pray, or too stressed to see the good in things.

Jeremiah 29:13 says:

"You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."

God is there to be found and seen, but we need to do some of the work in seeking him and staying in tune with him, so that we can recognise all the good things he is doing.
