So I realised I just needed to give the situation to God and try to trust that He has it in hand and knows how it will turn out. Easier said than done sometimes, I know.

Isaiah 55 is a chapter all about seeking God and coming to Him when we are thirsty, and verses 8 and 9 say,

"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."
