# St. Matt's Midweek Update - 9th December 2022



How is your week going? I hope you are managing to stay warm.

This morning I read something about serving. It was the passage in Acts 6:1-4, where the disciples receive a complaint that some of the widows are being overlooked and are not receiving food. The disciples chose seven men to take on this responsibility.

The thing in this passage that is good to notice, is that the same word for service is used for those looking after the widows and for those preaching and praying (diakonia), and both groups of people needed to have the same qualities - being full of the Spirit and wisdom.

Luke is telling us that all types of serving are equal when we are serving God. There aren't more important types of service - everything works together in serving God and caring for each other.

This is one of the strengths of our church, I think. Lots of people playing their part in serving in lots of different roles, and all working together to glorify God and share His love.

St. Matt's wouldn't run without volunteers, so this is a good chance to say **THANK-YOU** to all of you who contribute in any way to all the things we do as a church.

Thank you to everyone who makes our Sunday services happen (10am, 5pm and Seven), from those up front to PA and AV, welcome and coffee, and wardens.
