St. Matt's Midweek Update – 24th November 2023



How has your week been? Are you getting used to the dark mornings and evenings?

I find the dark, cold and rain quite tiring. It makes me not want to go outside and then I don't feel good because I'm not getting enough fresh air and exercise. I'm definitely a summer person!

Sometimes it can feel like the seasons we experience are a metaphor for our walk with God. I am definitely in a season at the moment where I don't feel very connected to God, I'm not in a good routine or habit of praying or spending quality time with God. When we are feeling like this, it is easy to feel that God is far away from us. We can think that He is not there, or that He is interested in other people but not us.

But I feel like God has reminded me this week that He is never far away from us. Whatever we feel about His presence in our lives, He is actually always there with us, always in our hearts, always there guiding us and helping us. How we feel about God or how much we can feel God is not about where God is, it is about our perception of where God is.

Psalm 139 is such an amazing Psalm, and verses 7-10 say this:
"Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence?
If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there.
If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea,
even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast."

Someone I met with yesterday prayed using the picture of God being our anchor. I like that picture of the unseen anchor on the seabed holding the boat fast. The boat may still be getting tossed and turned by the waves if it is stormy, but the anchor is always there keeping it steady.

So whatever you are feeling today, whatever your relationship with God is like at the moment, remember that He is with you, He is your anchor, and He will never leave you, and there is nothing you can do about that!
