St. Matt's Midweek Update – 11th April 2025



I hope you have had a good week.

This Sunday is the start of Holy Week, as we celebrate Palm Sunday together. As we start the last week of Jesus' life, we see him riding into Jerusalem on a donkey.

Palm Sunday is a great reminder of who Jesus is and what he is coming to do. The Jews of the time were waiting for a mighty Messiah, who would fight to save them from the Romans. So Jesus is making a real statement by riding into Jerusalem on a donkey - an animal that represented peace, not war. But then we also see that there were crowds of people in Jerusalem and with Jesus who recognised that this man was something special. The laying of cloaks and branches on the road showed that they thought he deserved special treatment, that he was someone to be honoured. They may not have realised exactly who Jesus was, but they knew something important was happening. They knew he was coming in the name of the Lord.

So this Palm Sunday, as we get a sense of our gentle, loving King, let's remember that we are also called to be like Jesus.

Philippians 2:6-8 says, "In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death even death on a cross!"
