Church lunch and afternoon at Adamswell - Sunday 6th July



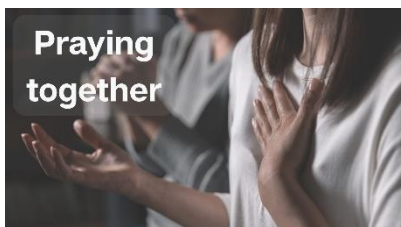
